Time: Part One: You will have 2 minutes to agree on a new change for American society and propose a gala event to mark its beginning. Include a water element.

Part Two: You will have 1 minute to explain your solution to the appraisers.

Materials: a pencil and a sheet of paper (for planning your solution only)

Scoring: up to 30 points for the innovation of the social “revolution”
(no points for including the Red Sox!)
up to 40 points for the creativity of the party planning
10 points for integrating something thrown into the water
up to 20 points for positive team work
